We are seeking an individual with a humble heart for God and one who directs their talents toward glorifying God. CCUM is in the process of updating technology to provide the best possible worship for the community and this is a great opportunity for the right candidate.

Qualifications & Skills Required:

1. The knowledge and understanding of digital mixing consoles and live stage equipment.
2. Proficiency in live and recorded audio techniques.
3. An ear for the mix and levels that enhance, not distract, from the overall worship experience.
4. Ability to work under the Production Director's supervision and the ability to work well in a team setting.
5. Ability to communicate in a positive way with others.
6. Ability to troubleshoot audio problems quickly and efficiently.
7. Ability to work along side volunteer members to facilitate the various A/V operation during worship as called for by Production Director.

Job Responsibilities and Duties:

1. Provide audio engineering for CCUM Sunday morning Traditional service (@8:30) and Blended Service (@11:00) as well as Sunday evening contemporary and student ministry services (2nd & 4th Sundays of the month @6:30).
2. Assist the Production Director in all things related to live/on-line production.
3. Set up/Tear down of audio equipment and gear for all services.
4. Mic and line check all persons requiring microphones in service.
5. Providing monitor support for all who utilize monitors in service.
6. Upkeep of audio equipment – Making sure things are clear of dust and covered, cleaning and storing A/V equipment as needed.
7. Be on time & prompt (Call time on Sunday mornings is 7am – For Sunday evenings it is 4:30pm)
8. Assist in the moving and arrangement of elements of altar/chancel for each service.
